What was I thinking?



# Hash T-shirts

Through the years, our hash has produced dozens of running shirts. Some of them are popular because they are comfortable for running (drip dry, 100% cotton, sweat shirt material, football jersey type of material). Others are popular because of its style (singlets, sleeveless, ¾ sleeve, V-neck, crew neck, collared neck). Some have obscene motif, some are more subtle but some are downright sacrilegious. For those hashmen whose maid or mother in some cases, does the laundry at home, I wonder what goes through their minds when they see some of the motifs on these t-shirts.

There are several series of running shirts. The first one that comes to mind is the red National Day singlet given out by mad Chinaman Boo CB year after year (until recently). Then, there is the colourful Capricorn run singlet/t-shirt by those birthday boys. The Mamas have their annual Deepavli (or Diwali depending which part of India you are from) run T-shirt that always feature the burning oil lamp. However, there was one year when they outdone themselves and came up with some poondan design of red and green oil lamps. Although the material was soft and feels comfortable, no hashmen would want to be seen in public wearing one of them because it was so queerish looking. There is also the annual Vaishakhi run staged by the Bhaiis giving away t-shirts with the crossed Kirpan. The Chinaman run T-shirt given out during Chinese new year usually feature the Chinese zodiac animal of that year. There was a short series of t-shirts given out by the Austrians and another by the Dutch in the customary Queen's orange.

Of the designs, couple of them were obscene enough to almost gotten our hashmen into trouble. One of them is the Austrian Alpine Erotica run with two peaks of the Austrian Alps drawn to look like the knees of a woman with her legs wide open. Bollocks was wearing that t-shirt when he was stopped by a police car. Another of the Austrian run featured the Austrian Coat of Arms, but the eagle had a hanging dick and a set of balls instead of the feathered tail. The 69th Eat-Out run featured two opposing faces within the numerals with their tongues wagging at each other. The Whip, who is usually associated with being a real prick, would have the outline of a prick splashed across the front of the t-shirt. This is another example of the type of T-shirt you would not like to take home for washing.

Once in a while, we get t-shirts or shorts with photograph of the hares. These are always in demand 20 years later when we want to know what so and so looked like when they just started hashing. Slime gave out a t-shirt with his own portrait super-imposed over the face of our 50 dollar bill. I think it is a matter of time before the Monetary Authority of Singapore ban that t-shirt.

To inject some variety into the customary t-shirts, some hares also provided us with track pants, bandana, wrap around sarong, fanny pack pouches, etc. These are always a welcome souvenir for visiting hasher to take back home to show others that they ran with the SELETAR HASH HOUSE HARRIERS.

# Hashing around the World

I ran my first hash run in the summer of 1967 with the Sandakan Hash House Harriers. Since then, I have gone on hash runs (excluding celebration runs) in Medan, Kathmandu, Abu Dhabi, Riyadh, Muscat, Washington DC, Dallas, San Diego and Beijing. I shall now recount some of my experiences running on these hashes.

The Sandakan hash was very small group in 1967 with no more than twenty runners each week. The Grand Master was the MD of the Anchor beer agent in town, which made it very convenient. Each week, the beer would be chilled for us and stored in the company landrover. The hares just had to drive the landrover to the run site. We could return whatever was left over and only pay for what was consumed.

Then, I lived in Medan for a while in 1979. I revived my hash interest and joined the Medan hash. During my time there, I earned my hash name NUTS, which I am proud to be associated with till today. Most expats arrive on the run site with chauffer driven cars, so during one of the runs, the hares managed to pull off an A to B run where they got the drivers to move all the vehicles to B after the runners set off, so that any short cutter would come back to an empty run site if they did not complete the run.

In 1980, I met several fellow officers from the Air Force at the KL Interhash, and I was invited me to join the Seletar Hash, so here I am today. In the eighties, I had the opportunity to travel to West Asia for work. Those were the days before the internet, so I was told that all I had to do was to call the Standard Chartered Bank or the British High Commission, and chances are, I would find a hasher there who can invite me to the hash. In Kathmandu, we usually ran through padi fields. In Abu Dhabi, Muscat and Riyadh, the runs which were set with flour, took us through the desert. Sometimes, the trail would end abruptly because the flour was eaten by some wild goats or camels.

Several months before my first run with the Riyadh hash, apparently, one of the hares who was setting a false trail, never returned and was found dead in the desert. Usually, no beer would be served after the run. Once, everyone was told to take a different route back into the city because the religious police had set up a road block to check on unmarried couples riding in the same car.

In the nineties, I travelled to the US frequently, so I had the opportunity to run with several of the hashes there. In Washington DC, I did a run in the snow. The trail was set by red paint sprayed on the white snow. In Dallas, one of the runs took us through a topless bar, and everyone was requested to stuff a dollar note into the stripper's g-string. In San Diego, I met a lady hasher who lived in Singapore and she remembered the Seletar Hash well.

In the early two thousands, I was spending a fair bit of time in Beijing, so I became a regular on the Beijing hash. One memorable weekend run, we travelled to a part of the Great Wall which was not a popular tourist spot. There, we spend overnight, sleeping on the wall under the stars. Next day, we were told that the wall is infested with scorpions and we were lucky that no one was bitten.

Of course, with the internet nowadays, one just had to surf the net and find out information about all the hashes around the world, their run sites each week and the contacts of the committee who may be able to guide you and/or arrange for a pickup to the hash. Through the hash, I am glad that I had a chance to make many friends as well as being able to visit the rural area of many different countries around the world.
